Tournament Rules

Iowa Elks 2016 State Bowling Tournament – March 12 & 13 and April 2 & 3

The entrants whose names appear in the schedule or their authorized substitutes hereby agree that the Iowa Elks Bowling Association officers and agents shall be liable only to the extent of returning fees in any event in a tournament delay, due to unforeseen schedule change or premature termination of the tournament that may be brought about by fire, flood, or any other cause beyond the control of the Iowa State Elks Association. After entries have been scheduled, there can be no refunds, except in the case of above listed acts.

General:

Prize fees collected will be prorated in case of any of the above listed acts. Each bowler may collect prize money for each event only once. . Prize Ratio will be 1 in 4 for Singles, Doubles, and Team. Prize Ratio will be 1 in 10 for All Events. All Events Champion will be highest 9 games scratch total and will receive a trophy for said score.

Averages:

Should the Tournament Director, at any time, ascertain that the average of any member of a team has been falsified, said entire team shall be disqualified. Prize money shall be forfeited and the bowlers will be subject to suspension from organized bowling.

The average will be figured from the highest average in league play from the preceding season, with a minimum of 21 games bowled. If no average from previous season, use highest average from current season with a minimum of 21 games bowled. If no league average for current season or previous season, an average of 170 will be issued to bowlers 61 years of age and younger. An average of 160 will be issued to bowlers 62 years of age and older. If bowlers do not have a current average but have bowled in the Elks State Bowling Tournament in previous years, an average from their past 2 times bowling in tournament shall be used. Handicap shall be 90% of 220.

Penalties for Rules Violation:

Any person who bowls under an assumed name of another bowler or team that uses a person that assumes the name of another bowler shall both individually and collectively forfeit their entry fee and prize money. All persons connected with the affair shall be forever disqualified in any and all tournaments sanctioned by the United States Bowling Congress (USBC).

USBC Rules:

Re-rating Rule No. 319 applies. Prize reporting Rule 319d is not applicable.

USBC Recognition:

Participating USBC members will receive high score recognition. Non-USBC members must qualify for this service by purchasing a USBC card prior to bowling. Substitutions on two man teams must bowl in position vacated by original entrant. City Association Secretary or Elks League Secretary must certify all averages.

Special Note: Early Entries will get top priority.
